

Building for life - Pastor Samuel's Story

Pastor Samuel Lucien and his wife, Marie, continue to work tirelessly from their Assemblies of God Church in Meilleur, Haiti. *Called by God to "reach unreachable souls for Him,"* they founded a primary school to provide education to children from the church and community.

Their greatest challenge came on January 12, 2010. The earthquake that shook Haiti, collapsed their church.

"We didn't really know what to do to rebuild the church," said Pastor Samuel. "We started a revival to gain strength in Jesus and we prayed for God to provide us with support.

Then God sent Builders International to assist us with the reconstruction of the church. Builders International has been a tool in the hands of the Lord to provide this building to the community. Before the earthquake we had about 440 people. Now, more than 1000 people are worshiping the Lord in our beautiful new building, which also serves as a shelter in case of natural disasters."

Since the church building was rebuilt, not only has it grown, but four additional churches have been planted and the school has also doubled in size. With all of this growth, the church itself was able to fund the expansion for the school.
